Minors as Volunteers

Volunteers under the age of 18 must have written consent of a parent or guardian prior to volunteering.

Position Description

Volunteers will be given guidance regarding their duties and responsibilities. This will include a description of the position or task, a designated supervisor and worksite, time frame for the performance of the job and a listing of qualifications needed.
